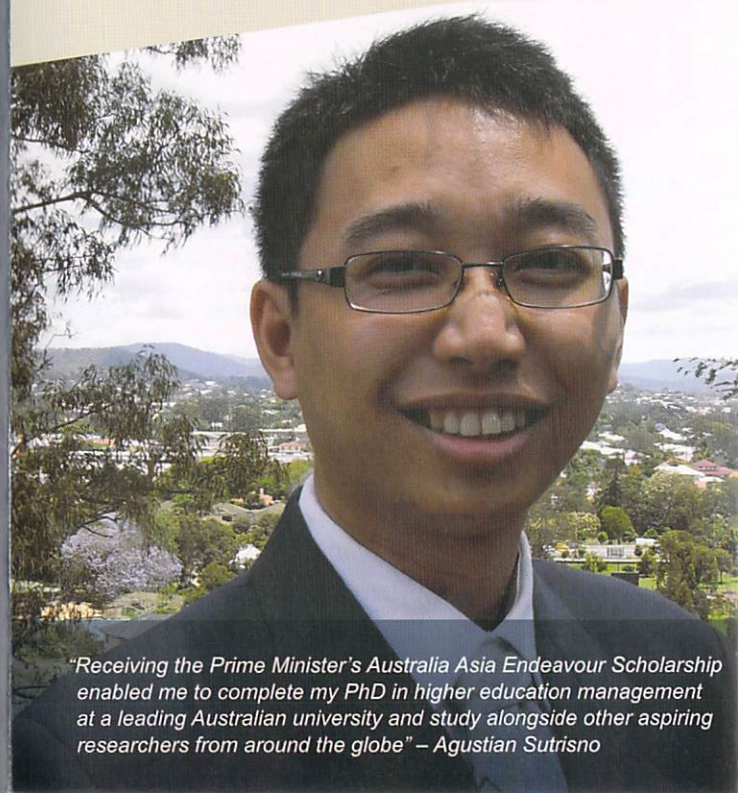

Application process

3. Eligible applications are assessed by independent selection panels made up of academic staff and other professionals.
4. Applications open in April and close 30 June for commencement the following year.
